Job Purpose:

The Recoveries Manager is responsible for overseeing the collection and recovery of non-performing loans (NPLs) and overdue accounts within the Shelter Afrique. This role ensures the implementation of effective debt recovery strategies while aligning with the bank's mission of financial inclusion and sustainable development. The Recoveries Manager will collaborate with legal, credit risk, and portfolio management teams to minimize credit losses and maximize recoveries.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead the Special Operations Unit (SOU), designing and implementing financial restructuring, recovery solutions, and quick exit strategies for non-performing or distressed investments.
- o Analyze non-performing and impaired projects/transactions, recommending the best recovery strategies for approval.
- o Coordinate financial forecasting and conduct cash flow analysis to assess project viability.
- O Develop and implement exit plans for re-possessed assets and written-off cases, ensuring minimal exposure.
- o Effectively manage stakeholders to deliver results within set timelines.
- Lead discussions on potential refinancing, turnaround strategies, workouts, enforcement, insolvency processes, and debt-for-equity swaps for NPL projects.
- o Monitor the financial and operational performance of impaired investments/projects and ensure execution of agreed workout strategies.
- Prepare and present regular NPL management reports to the Management Credit Committee and Board Investment Committee.
- o Identify and share lessons learned from SOU workout experiences to improve investment strategies within the organization.
- Set performance targets and milestones for SOU staff and conduct performance assessments.
- o Supervise and mentor SOU team members, fostering professional growth.
- o Continuously review, develop, and improve SOU policies, procedures, and guidelines to enhance operational efficiency.
